

WEG qualification – European Junior Championship participation

Vaulters, in order to qualify for the 2006 World Championship, must have attained an average score of 6.0 points or higher in one round from at least two CVI2*s in Europe (one CVI2*/1* outside Europe, provided the horse canters left).

The score(s) must have been attained during the period from 1st January 2005 until the closing date for definite entries.

National Federations will be responsible for ensuring that the vaulters comply with these qualifications. Certificates of capability will not be required, however, proof of each vaulter's result(s) must be held by the relevant Chef d'Equipe at the Championship and must be shown to the Technical Delegate if and when requested to do so.

Please note:

Vaulters will have to choose between participating in the WEG Aachen or in the European Junior Championship 2006 in Munich (team 1* competition) - it will not be possible to attend both.
